1989 NATIONAL SWIM AND CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

Attached submission of the N.S.W. Branch provides details of a Swim Programme and Budget for the 1989 National Swim which is to be held in Sydney.

The proposal looks to the future by providing:

- * Individual medals for each age group within an event.
- * A limit of five (5) individual events with a maximum of two (2) events per day.
- * A programme designed to be conducted over four (4) days to maximise team participation.
- * A club and individual programme designed to engender a team spirit of AUSSI.
- * Provision for presentation of medals during the same day's programme.

RATIONALE

The proposed changes and recommendations are based upon their successful implementation in the 1988 N.S.W. State Cup which was conducted in conjunction with the Bicentennial National Club Postal Swim.

Individual Entries

An increase of 25% in individual entries from the previous year's entry figure was received in response to the prior advertisement for the provision of individual medals. This increase in entries cannot in any way be attributed to the National Postal event as other statistics tabled confirm.

Swimmers who competed in a limited number of events in their particular stroke speciality were not disadvantaged and were rewarded for their individual effort.

Relay Entries

The number of entries received for relay events also increased substantially. It is considered that this increase was attributed, in part, to the reduction in individual events undertaken by each competitor on a daily basis.

Atmosphere

The atmosphere at poolside was electric. Clubs were heard to barrack for each of their individual swimmers. The noise during relay events can only be described as deafening. This in turn contributed to an unbelievable spectacle when the victors were presented with their medals at poolside.
