



VI WORLD MASTERS SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS SHEFFIELD '96

Rule Changes at Swimming Technical Congress Affect Masters

At the FINA Swimming Technical Congress held in Rome, 31 August 1994, several corrections, precisions and technical amendments were brought to the Swimming Rules. Some of these changes will be of particular interest to Masters. The underlined portions are the new clarifications.

The Backstroke turn rule (SW 6.4) was amended to read:
During the turn, the shoulders may be turned over the vertical to the breast after which a continuous single arm pull or a continuous simultaneous double arm pull may be used to initiate the turn. Once the body has left the position on the back, there will be no kick or arm pull that is independent of the continuous turning action. The swimmer must have returned to a position on the back upon leaving the wall. When executing the turn there must be a touch of the wall of some part of the swimmer's body.

The Breaststroke rule (SW 7.3) for the pull now reads:
The hands shall be pushed forward together from the breast on, under or over the water. The elbows shall be under the water except for the last stroke. The hands shall be brought back on or under the surface of the water. The hands shall not be brought back beyond the hip line, except for the first stroke after the start and each turn.

The Butterfly turn rule (SW 8.4) now reads:
At each turn and at the finish of the race, the touch shall be made with both hands simultaneously, at, above or below the water surface. The shoulders shall remain in the horizontal plane until the touch is made.

The Backstroke and Medley Relay start rule (SW 4.2) was also amended. There will now be a second long whistle from the referee in the Backstroke start. After the first long whistle to get the swimmers into the water, the second long whistle will tell the swimmer to immediately take up the starting position.

Attention is drawn to Age Group Rule SWAG 1. This rule does not pertain to Masters Swimming which is covered by MGR 4 which states that "Age shall be determined as of December 31 of the year of competition." Rule MGR 4 is not in conflict with the introduction to Masters Rules which is a general statement only and defines the age at which entry is permitted. MGR 4 is specific and gives the age definition for Masters and governs the entry and exit for all age groups.

Countdown Begins

Months of preparatory work are now coming to fruition for the Committee organising the 1996 World Masters Swimming Championships in Sheffield.

Tremendous interest is being generated in the forthcoming VI World Masters Swimming Championships to be held in Sheffield, 22-June to 3 July 1996. Events will include Swimming, Open Water Swimming, Diving, Water Polo and Synchronised Swimming. The Championships are being held for the first time in Europe and, judging by the interest being shown, could well be one of the biggest swim meets ever held.

All the events, with the exception of Open Water Swimming, will be hosted at the Ponds Forge International Sports Centre in the centre of the City of Sheffield. The 5km swim will be held at the Holme Pierrepont National Water Sports Centre in Nottingham, approximately 45 minutes from Sheffield. Both venues are world class. Ponds Forge will provide state-of-the-art facilities for all disciplines and is widely acknowledged as one of the best swimming pools in the world. It was the flag ship venue for the World Student Games hosted in Sheffield in 1991. In 1993 it also played host to the European Swimming Championships.

The Organising Committee have left no stone unturned to make the Championships a resounding success.

After many months of detailed work the Information and Entry Booklet was published right on schedule in March and this has now been distributed throughout the world. The booklet is the product of the experience gained in running five previous World Masters Championships and contains a wealth of detail as well as many innovations.

Sheffield will be a popular venue. Although the fifth largest city in Britain, it is a friendly working city with a truly distinctive country setting. For the first time visitor Sheffield is a revelation. Perhaps the greatest surprise is its stunning location. More than one third of Sheffield lies within the beautiful Peak District National Park. It is built on seven hills and five rivers and has more than fifty parks and abundant woodlands. In Sheffield, sport is an industry and the city is fast becoming the sporting capital of England. It boasts some of the best sports and leisure facilities in the country. Accommodation at a reasonable price is available close at hand at the University and a recently built light rail network will provide excellent transport within the city. Without a doubt, Masters Swimmers will certainly be eagerly awaiting next years World Championships.

Judging Masters Swimming Events

There is an Unwritten golden rule stating that the function of the judge is to ensure that all competitors compete under equal conditions and that no one gets an unfair advantage over the other competitors. This means that infringements of the rules shall be punished with disqualification. However the judge and the referee must be absolutely certain that the swimmer did break a rule. We DO NOT disqualify for bad swimming technique and, if there is the slightest element of doubt as to whether a rule has been broken, the swimmer is NOT to be disqualified. Any doubt shall be for the benefit of the swimmer.


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
Qualifying Standards for selected events at Sheffield

As part of the measures taken to reduce the programme for the World Masters Swimming championships in Sheffield, the 800m Freestyle and the 400m Individual Medley events are subject to the qualifying standards stated below. The standards are based on a set percentage above current world records. These events will be deck-seeded.

Ask the 'World' a Question !

David Tree expands on his theme of a world-wide swimming information network.

- People with interests similar to yours want to hear from you. Might take a decade or two to connect should you not live on the same continent! I always get replies when I post queries about a Masters swimming related problem.
- United States Masters Swimming and Masters Swimming Canada now have current Internet services available. I predict the majority of Masters swimming countries will have services available on-line within five years.
- Whole libraries are accessible via the 'net'. As well, many magazines are starting electronic versions of their printed magazine. Some magazines are only available electronically. Several of the magazines I now subscribe to have 'net' versions accessible.
- You can write a private note to a friend in London (England), Poznan (Poland), or Arvada (Colorado, USA) and get it to them instantly. Or perhaps you prefer to share a thought with the world-wide readership on a USENET newsgroup. Ask the world and the world will answer.

The on-line "net" community has its own unique culture and spirit of co-operation. Respecting and understanding how things work on-line may require you to be patient and observant during your first few visits to a particular area. However, most users pick up the basics pretty fast. On-line regulars are usually very patient when questions are thrown their way. Understanding some of the technology will make users a lot more comfortable. The most basic service is electronic mail or "e-mail".

The Internet is a global storehouse of information. Information in all formats including sound and motion pictures and yes, simple text, can be retrieved. Countless thousands of gigabytes of information!

Okay, I admit that Internet is not for everyone. Here are a few reasons that some one might like to use the "net".

Sure, you can go to the library and look up more information on arthritis, swimmer's shoulder, nutrition, etc. You can also contact a friend of a friend to find out what might be wrong with the new software that you are using for THE swim meet of the season. The company that produced the software happens to be on line on the "net" as are many other users of the software. Or perhaps you want to get hold of one of countless Masters leaders throughout the world who just happen to have Internet accounts.

I can access companies which specialise in everything from computers to cooking with a few strokes on my keyboard. Many companies and most universities NOW have full Internet access. Check the next business card someone gives you ... odds are that there is an email address listed.

Perhaps you wonder what the winning time was in the women's 1500m Freestyle at the Barbados International Masters meet or the Championnats de France Masters Open. Maybe you wonder what the current world or national records are in the men's 50-54 age group. Sure, you can wait a month or two for the results to arrive by mail.

(I prefer spelling it as "email"). The number of email users is not known exactly, but is estimated as high as 60 million and next year it will be 80 million or more! Almost every second business card I receive has an email address on it. Just three years ago, I rarely found an email address on a business card.

Who has an email address? It might soon be easier to ask "who doesn't?". Educators, scientists, business people, researchers, politicians, students, magazine and newsletter editors, and virtually every high technology company. Included in this total are the countless Masters swimming leaders (and swimmers) that I mentioned earlier. Most people wonder how they ever managed without email after using email for just a month or two.

Alas, not everyone has free access to Internet at their place of employment. The good news is that the cost of accessing the 'net' continues to drop. Further drops in access cost were announced on the day that I wrote this article. Also, there are many free-nets in larger centres. Internet is not for everyone. Curiosity, adventure and a thirst for knowledge are a must!

If you would like more information on USENET (try <rec.sport.swimming>), feel free to email me. I can't guarantee that I will answer your questions, but the price is right ... free!

News Briefs

Exotic venue

The 1998 VII World Masters Swimming Championships have been awarded to Casablanca, the largest city and chief seaport of Morocco. The decision was made at the FINA Bureau meeting held in Bangkok, Thailand, 28-30 March 1995. This will be the first major Masters swimming event ever held on the African continent and the historic city of Casablanca should provide a most exciting and popular venue. Organisation for the event is already under way and the FINA Masters Committee met there in late May.

FINA awards to Masters

At the recent FINA Bureau meeting, two members of the Masters Committee were honoured with the award of the FINA Silver Pin. These were Doug Scales of Great Britain and Tom Logan of New Zealand. The awards were for outstanding service during three terms of office on the international FINA Masters Committee and for their dedication and contribution to the sport of Swimming.

Centenarians abound

Hard on the heels of the historic performances of Tom Lane at the Montreal World Masters Swimming Championships comes news of a further member of this age group. At the recent World Masters Games in Brisbane, Australia, 101 years old Mary Maina of Queensland's Gold Coast created history and pandemonium in the stands when she won the 50m Freestyle event in the time of 05:12:00 to establish the first World Women's Record in the new 100 - 104 years age group. At the same time she was creating State and National records.

European news

The new LEN Masters Committee have started their work. They are working on a four year plan to promote activity in all the Masters disciplines. A "Masters Club Europe" is to be formed which will offer special services including insurance and distribution of information. The 1995 European Masters Swimming and Diving Championships will be held in Riccione, Italy 6-10 September. Entries have been limited to 5 individual events per swimmer but there are no qualifying times this year. There are however cut-off times for both the 400m and 800m Freestyle events. The event, which is restricted to Europeans only, is expected to attract large entries.


Individuals are listed in order of age group and then alphabetically by name, in order of events and then date. Relay teams are in order of relay age group and then in order of relay event and then date.



Walter Reid, World Masters Recorder

World records for Masters were initially established by Masters Swimming International during the 1980's. First came the long course records compiled by Peter Gillett and then the short course under Judy Ford. These two Australians did a tremendous job over the years in establishing these lists. Next came the annual publishing of the top ten rankings. On taking over the maintenance of these statistics in 1992, FINA was faced with a formidable task. There are a potential 1,152 Masters records and with the ever increasing spread of the Masters Swimming movement, the appointment of a World Masters Recorder with the necessary background knowledge became a matter of urgency.

Walter Reid first became involved in Masters statistics in 1979 when he took over as Recorder for his local area in the Pacific Northwest of the United



States. Initially he did it all manually, including meticulously hand printing the lists and records. By profession he is a timber inventory specialist working for a timber company. This involves much computer work and Walt was able to write his own program to do the Masters statistics. This program was then expanded, first to cover the United States Masters Top Ten Rankings and Records and then the World Top Ten Rankings and Records.

Walter has been the chairman of the USMS Records and Tabulation Committee for eight years. He has also served on other USMS Committees and in 1991 received the 1991 Ransom J. Arthur Award for outstanding services to United States Masters Swimming. After producing the Masters Swimming International Top Ten lists for some years, he was appointed as the FINA Masters World Recorder in 1992 and with responsibility for the World Top Ten Rankings and World Records.

In addition to all this, Walt Reid is a swimmer too! He even married his swimming coach - Kathy Casey - one of the top swimmers in United States Masters Swimming. His specialty is breaststroke. He swam competitively both at high school and at the University of Washington in Seattle where he gained a degree in forestry. He followed this with a masters degree in forestry at Yale University in New Haven, Connecticut. We are indeed fortunate in having a World Recorder with the dedication and ability to do this painstaking job.
