## Sheffield World Masters - a huge success

Four years of planning, a masterly attention to detail and the superb Management Team, resulted in the World Master Swimming Championships, held in Sheffield, 21 June - 3 July 1996, being an outstanding success.

Heading the Organising Committee was Andrew Mathews, most ably assisted by Sue Catton. Their friendly "hands on" approach was a major factor in the success of what was the largest multi-discipline Swimming Meet ever held. Behind the organisation was the support of both the Sheffield City administration led by the Lord Mayor, Councillor Peter Price, and the various Swimming bodies of Great Britain.

Competing at the Championships were an amazing 4,555 swimmers aged from 25 to 95 years. They came from 46 countries and representing some 1,279 different clubs. They transformed Sheffield into a global village occupying thousands of beds throughout the city.

During the day they competed in Swimming, Open Water Swimming, Diving, Water Polo and Synchronised

Swimming for a total of some 4,500 medals. For twelve days, from 8-00am to early evening, the magnificent Ponds Forge International Sports Centre resounded to the noise of excited spectators supporting their team members. In the spacious foyer, dining rooms and support areas, competitors from all over the world mixed and made friends at what was undoubtedly one of the World's great sporting occasions.

In the evenings they attended the wide variety of social functions provided by the organisers or simply relaxed with old or newly found friends and did what they enjoy most - talking about Swimming.

FINA would like to congratulate the organisers, officials and the competitors for making the 1996 VI World Masters Championships such a brilliant occasion.

## Competitors make valuable input

During the World Championships opportunity was given to Masters to express their views on how future Championships should be conducted. The opinions expressed were documented and were considered at the three day post Championship meeting of the FINA Masters Committee. Detailed recommendations concerning the conduct of future Championships were formulated and were forwarded to the FINA Bureau for consideration.

### World Forum

The first ever FINA Masters World Forum was held in Sheffield on 21 June at the Sports Hall of the Ponds Forge Pool. The Forum is to be held every four years immediately prior to the Championships. The Forum will alternate every two years with the Masters Technical Congress and provides a direct line of communication with FINA for Masters swimmers.

The Forum was opened by FINA Vice President, Artie Shaw who was also present in his capacity as FINA Bureau Liaison Officer to the Masters Committee. The meeting was attended by 25 Delegates from 16 Member Federations as well as by 34 observers. The Chairman of the Masters Committee, Doug Scales, introduced to the meeting members of his Committee and also the Director of the FINA Permanent Office, Cornel Marculescu.

A wide agenda covering the World Championships was discussed. This agenda included venues, programme content, qualifying standards, entry limitations, finances and Masters officials. A variety of suggestions were put forward by the Delegates and some valuable points emerged. In general there was a surprising agreement on most subjects including the necessity for some form of limitation on entry to the Championships.

### Questionnaires

Comprehensive questionnaires were distributed to competitors in Sheffield. A total of 592 responses from 30 countries responded to the Swimming questionnaire. There were 26 responses from 9 countries to the Diving questionnaire and all 8 participating countries responded to the Synchronised Swimming questionnaire. An analysis of the views expressed was undertaken by Bruce Rogers, the Masters Committee Secretary, and a team of helpers. This analysis was available for the post Championship meeting of the Masters Committee.

Sheffield's Alternative Bongo Band led the Opening Ceremony at the Ponds Forge Pool. Speeches were given by Dave Morris, President of the Amateur Swimming Federation of Great Britain, Artie Shaw, the FINA Vice President and the Lord Mayor of Sheffield, Councillor Peter Price.

The Lord Mayor put on his trunks to swim in the 50m Breaststroke on Day 4 of the Championships as an event special guest. The keep-fit Councillor, affectionately known locally as "Lord Peter", also attended the Open Water Swim in company with the Mayor of Nottingham.





The Swimming was held at the Ponds Forge Pool over a period of 7 days, 22-28 June. There were 3,837 swimmers (2,045 men and 1,792 women) representing 46 countries and 1,279 clubs. There were 10,902 individual starts and, with 10 lanes in use, there were 1,289 heats.

The competition started at 0800 hours each day and ran continuously with no breaks. The finishing times each day were:

Day 1 - 1700 Day 2 - 1830 Day 3 - 1730 Day 4 - 1730  
Day 5 - 1745 Day 6 - 1600 Day 1 - 1545

This was a satisfactory result and far more acceptable than the late hours experienced in Montreal. The measures taken to restrict the programme each day were successful.

The management of this huge meet was outstanding. The FINA delegate was Artie Shaw and the Meet Director was Malcolm Hill who was also a member of the Organising Committee. The Chief Referee was Arthur Knudsen and he was assisted by a team of 8 Referees. Under their direction a large team of officials and helpers ensured that the meet went off without a hitch. Behind the scenes in the computer room was a highly skilled team of timing system operators together with Tom Taylor from HY-TECK and Walter Reid, the Masters Recorder.

The standard of swimming was high. There were 91 World Records broken including 40 Women's (4 from splits), 47 Men's and 4 Relay. These provisional records have been annotated in the results on pages 3 - 8.

The records, when ratified, will be acknowledged in the December issue of the FINA Masters News.

In the space available it is impossible to comment on the many outstanding individual performances. However mention must be made of the brilliant swimming of June Krauser (USA), a member of the FINA Master Committee, who gained 5 titles and 7 records in the Women's 70-74 yrs age group. In the Men's there was Roberto Alberiche (ESP) who created a sensation in winning 5 titles in record times in the highly competitive 65-69 yrs age group. Another multiple record breaker was Dagmar Frese (GER) in the Women's 40-44 yrs age group who gained 4 records.

# OPEN WATER SWIMMING RESULTS

## First, Second and Third Placings

The 4.5km Masters Open Water Championships was held on Saturday 29 June at the rowing course of the magnificent Holme Pierrepont National Water Sports Centre at Nottingham, approximately 100km from Sheffield. The original distance of 5kms was shortened to 4.5kms to simplify the course which was one complete circuit. Provision had been made to further shorten the distance should there be adverse weather conditions. The weather on the day was not good, with a chilly wind prevailing. However the water temperature, because of the shallow depth of the rowing course, was at an average of 19.50C, which was an acceptable level.

A total of 406 swimmers were entered for the Championships. On the day, because of the adverse weather conditions, 296 (108 women and 188 men) actually entered the water. Of these, 14 retired from the race and 282 completed the distance. In view of the low water temperature and unpleasant surface conditions this was a most creditable result and reflected well on the general fitness and preparedness of those competing.

The standard of swimming was high. First woman home was 35 year old Lynn Marshall of Canada with a time of 01:00:01:70. Two 30 year old German swimmers, Uwe Liebermann and Mario Koch, shared the honour of leading the men with identical times of 00:57:11:53. The oldest woman competitor Erna Eichmann (71 yrs.) of Germany with Lennart Ingmo (77 yrs.) being the oldest man. Medals were awarded to competitors finishing in first through to sixth place in each age group.

The event was organised by a committee headed by Amanda Hunt. The Chairman of the FINA Open Water Swimming Committee, Alan Clarkson, was Chief Referee. As in all the other events, attention to detail was evident in all aspects and the use of hand-held radios ensured that at all times the event was under complete control. The electronic recording team was housed in the rowing control tower and this was connected by land line to the finishing point.

The race was started in nine waves based on age groups with the younger age groups going first. This method seemed to avoid the bunching which occurred in Montreal and the provision of a "funnel" finish avoided difficulties in placing swimmers. All swimmers wore numbered swim caps with a different colour for each wave. Numbers were also tattooed on each swimmers shoulder. There were motorised safety boats and a fleet of canoes. There were two ambulances in constant attendance and these were backed up by other vehicles. Because road access was available at close hand right around the course, the safety factor was high.

Provision for the competitors included a hot meal being provided at the cafeteria on completion of the race. The caterers were taken by surprise by the number of supporters attending and their facilities were stretched to the full. This unfortunately meant that many swimmers missed out on their meal. In hindsight it would have been better if hot drinks and some food could have been available immediately for swimmers at the finishing point.

The Diving was held at the Ponds Forge Diving Pool from 30 June to 3 July. The facilities were ideal with mechanical surface agitation and a dark blue pool bottom to assist "spotting". A total of 175 Divers had registered. In the event, the actual number participating was 161, (59 Women and 102 Men), and they performed 3,507 dives, (1,234 Women's and 2,273 Men's). The events were witnessed each day by an appreciative audience.

Unlike the Swimming, the Diving had a rather long 12 hours day and this made for an overly long meet. This was not fair on the divers who had to compete late and the officials who had to stay late. Scheduling and other aspects are being addressed to ensure this does not happen in the future.

Directing operations was the Diving Co-ordinator, Adrian Hinchcliffe. Ricky Wood was the Meet Director and Birger Kivela was Head Referee. They were supported by a most able team of officials and judges. Medals were awarded to Divers finishing in 1st. to 6th. places in each age group. A formal presentation ceremony took place at the end of the pool at the conclusion of each day's competition.

Oldest Diver was Viola Krahn of the U.S.A. (95 years) who was also oldest competitor at the meet. She provided a sensation when she competed so competently in the 1 metre Springboard event. Oldest man was Ernie Webster (85 years) from Australia. The Platform Diving proved most popular with the crowd especially when the older Men's age-groups competed.

The "Gumby Award" went to Hans-Dieter Prophal (55-59 yrs) who hit the 7 metre tower while diving in the Platform event, flipped over and failed his dive. Regardless of this mishap, he still managed to finish in 3rd place to make a German clean sweep and hat trick in the age group.

A great Championships which augurs well for the future of Masters Diving.

# WATER POLO RESULTS

## Team Standings

On 30th June, 29 teams from 4 continents converged on the Ponds Forge pool to compete in Masters Water Polo. There were a number of firsts for the VI Masters World Championships.

- A Women's team was competing.
- Medals were contested in four age divisions.
- This was a four day competition.

Under the able direction of the Tournament Director, Mike Glover, a total of 79 games were played in two courses over a four day span. Full marks to the Amateur Swimming Association's Water Polo Division for providing ample support personnel and referees. It made the experience that much more enriching for the competition.

In the 30+ division, 12 teams were in competition and divided into two brackets playing a round robin. From there, the top two in each bracket played in the medal round. Winning the semi-final games were the Olympic Club of San Francisco, California and Aeroflot Masters from Kazakhstan. They had competed in the first round and the final was definitely a grudge match. Playing for the bronze were the Chicago Apostles of the USA and CAMO from Canada, (the 1992 World Masters Champions).

In the final, the Olympic Club built on their defence and fast break offence to take home the gold, while Chicago Apostles relied on outside shooting and strong 2-meter play to receive the bronze.

In the 35+ division, a round robin was played and at the end, the Gold Coast team from the USA was at the top, winning all of their games. Second was Schwimmverein Cannstatt 1898 from Germany with the Stara Sava team from Croatia taking the third position.

Again playing a round robin in the 40+ age group, the undefeated gold medal team was Szentes Senior SE from Hungary. Silver went to Veteran 70, Split and the bronze was nabbed by Birkenhead from Great Britain.

The Women's team, a 30+ group of ladies from Sheffield, was placed with the 45+/50+ Men in another round robin division. The women acquitted themselves well winning twice during the tournament, but they were not in the medal hunt. Coming away with the win were the West Valley Outlaws from the USA who clinched a squeaker from another USA team, Second Effort LA who won the silver. Rounding out the division was SA Masters 45 from South Africa with the bronze.
