RENDEZ-VOUS FINA IN CASABLANCA

VIIth WORLD MASTERS SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS

In the beautiful City of Casablanca, in Morocco, everything is ready to welcome next year, from 19 to 30 June 1998, several thousands of participants : swimmers, divers, synchronized swimmers, specialists of long distance swimming over 25 years old and water-polo players over 30 years old.

In a message written for the Official Publication of this Event, the FINA President, Mr Mustapha Larfaoui declares: "FINA, with the help of its 166 National Federations is trying to extend the practice of all its sports disciplines for people of all ages. More and year, for the first time, this rendez-vous will be held in Africa in Casablanca, an astonishing and attractive City ..."

The FINA Masters Committee met on the sites of the next World Masters Swimming Championships, in Casablanca, on May 30-31, 1997 under the chairmanship of Mr Victor Nogueira in the presence of Dr Julio Maglione, FINA Honorary Treasurer and Nory Krutchen, Bureau Liaison. The Minister of Sports of Morocco welcomed all participants and promised the support of the State and all local authorities. Mr Ahmed Zaki, President

FINA MASTERS TECHNICAL CONGRESS June 18, 1998 Casablanca, MAR

For this Congress according to FINA Rule C 13.7 "all motions, applications and proposals for alterations or additions to the Technical Rules shall only be considered, if submitted by a Member, the Bureau or the respective Technical Committee". Please note that the deadline for presenting the motions, applications and proposals for the FINA Masters Rules should be received by the FINA Office in Lausanne (SUI) NO LATER THAN ON 18th of OCTO-BER 1997 (application of Rule C.13.7)

Each FINA Member Federation may appoint two (2) Delegates to this Congress. The registration forms must be sent to the FINA Office, in Lausanne (SUI), NO LATER THAN THE 30th of APRIL 1998. All expenses for the Delegates, such as travel, accomodation, meals and other items should be covered by each National Federation.

AFTER CASABLANCA MUNICH (GER)

During the FINA Bureau Meeting in Gothenburg last April, the City of Munich (GER) was chosen to be the host in 1999 of the VIIIth FINA World Masters Championships. The choice was difficult, as Perth (AUS) was the other excellent candidate city.

Biographical Notes by June F. Krauser

Victor NOGUEIRA is the Chairman and lives in Lisboa (POR). He is 50 years young and in business he represents a pharmaceutical company. For twenty years his children have been in swimming. He is presently President of the Portugal Swimming Federation. This is his first term on the Masters Committee.

Lin Min SHAN is the Vice Chairman and lives in Taipei (TPE). This is Lin's third term on the Masters Committee. For twelve years Lin was Secretary General of the Chinese Taipei Swimming Association and is currently Chairman of the Asian Masters Federation. Lin has competed in all eight of the Masters World Championships.

Bruce C. ROGERS C.A. divides his time between Oakville, Ontario (CAN) and Ft Lauderdale, Florida (USA). He has been Secretary-Treasurer of ASUA and Secretary of the Aquatic Federation of Canada. This is Bruce's second term on the Masters Committee and he serves as Honorary Secretary. Bruce has competed in the two last World Masters Championships in Montreal and Sheffield.

Ross M. CODY lives in Guayanabo (PUR). Twenty years ago Rose brought synchronized swimming to Puerto Rico. Her daughter competed in the sport. Rose is on the 1997 FINA Synchronized Swimming Judges List. She worked with Bruce on the ASUA Committee since 1975.

Allam FARID is a first time member and he lives in Casablanca (MAR). He was a swimmer and water polo player until retiring in 1972. He is the General Secretary of the Moroccan Swimming Federation, President of the Masters Committee of Africa and General Secretary of the 1998 VII FINA Masters World Swimming Championships. He is also a judge for swimming and water polo.

Daniel GARCIA, member of the Masters Committee since 1992, is a Sports Medicine Doctor. President of the Federacion Uruguaya de Natacion

ce 1988, he was doctor of his national delegans at the South American, Pan-American, mpic Games or World Championships between 1-231 and 1988.

June F. KRAUSER has competed in all six World Championships and every USA National Championships since 1972. It is her third term on the Masters Committee. She was the second President of United States Masters for four years and Rules Chairman for 22 years. Currently she is on several National Committees, a Zone Rep and local Registration Chairman and Treasurer. June holds national and world records and competes in many competitions throughout the year.

Tarja LILJESTROM lives in Helsinki (FIN) and she is a new member of the Masters Committee. She started diving at a young age and also coached diving. She was inactive until the Masters movement came along and as she loves diving and competing she got back into shape. Tarja is on the LEN Diving Committee and competed in Sheffield. She lectures and loves music.

Lyall MORTIMER is a Business Adviser (Health & Strategy) Marketing & Product Development Unit living in Wellington (NZL). He works for the Department of Labor. He has been in swimming all his life through his children. A life member of his club, he is also a Past President of New Zealand

Masters. He was meet director of one World Championship meet and has swum in four World Championships.

Zvi RUTTERT, another new member, has spent twenty years in his Federation. He lives in Savyon (ISR). He is deeply involved in all sports - particularly open water swimming.

Frantisek STOCHI lives in Plzen (CZE). He was one of the referees in Sheffield at the last World Championships. Frank is now head of the Czech Swimming Federation, a member of the LEN Masters Committee and also a member of the Long Distance Swimming Committee. This is Frank's first time on the Masters Committee.

Ivan WINGATE started swimming at age 18 and swam with Dawn Fraser. He lives in Tusmore SA (AUS). After leaving the amateur swimming ranks he helped organize the Professional Coaches. He currently serves Aussi Masters Swimming as their National Executive Director. This is Ivan's first tour on the Masters Committee.

Nory KRUTCHEN is the Bureau Member Liaison to the FINA Masters Committee. He lives in Echtmach (LUX). He is a physical education teacher. Nory has been with the Luxembourg Swimming Federation since 1978 and he is still Secretary General. He has been both a coach and a referee. He is currently Treasurer of the LEN.

NEWS BRIEFS * 1997 LATIN-AMERICA AND CARIBBEAN MASTERS SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS

This coming September, the 4th Latin-American and Caribbean Masters Swimming Championships will be held at Oaxtepec, Mexico. This event is open ONLY to residents of Latin America and the Carribbean. The organizing committee for this meet is expecting close to 1,000 participants for the 5day meet including an open-water race and a socalled "pre-master" category from 19-24.

* 1997 LEN CHAMPIONSHIPS IN PRAGUE

The next European Masters Swimming and Diving Championships will take place in the Czech Republic capital Prague on September 3-7, 1997. There will be some minor changes to the program of the last Championships held in Riccione (ITA) in 1995. The program was discussed by the LEN Masters Committee during their annual meeting in Jerusalem and has since been approved by the LEN Bureau.

Due to the very large entries in the past (2,854 swimmers in 1995), the LEN Masters Committee have decided on qualifying times for the 1997 Championships. These will only apply to 200m, 400m and 800m events. if a competitor fails to finish his event within the entry time, he will be placed without time or placing in the result list. The no false start rule will also be enforced and overhead starts will be utilized. In the 400 m and 800m freestyles there is to be deck seeding and two competitors in each line if necessary. The Championships are only open to registered Masters of LEN Federations.

* PUERTO RICO

Professor Manuel Jose de Jesus informed us that the National Championships in Puerto Rico will be open to all masters. Dates: August 15-17, 1998. Site : Piscina Universidad, Sagardo Corazon, Santurce. Information : fax 790-4333.

* USA

The 28th annual United States Masters Swimming National Short Course Championships took place on May 16-18 at one of the finest aquatic centers of the country, the King County Weyerhaeuser Aquatics center located in Federal Way, in Washington. The weather was gorgeous.

The meet started at 7.00 AM on three of the four days and consequently there were very early warm ups but it was nice to be through before dinner. It was the first time that the men started before the women. After the women starting first for the first 27 years it was a little difficult getting used to having the men go first.

There were 160 different clubs competing in three categories - Large Team, Medium Team and Small Team. There were 1,661 swimmers entered in the meet with 987 men and 574 women. All of the short course individual events were swum plus four relays - the 200m freestyle relay, the 200m medley relay, the 200 mixed freestyle relay and the 200 mixed medley relay.

The results are available and for the Women's Team Scores the Small Team (9 swimmers or less) was won by Rinconada Masters from California: Medium Team (10-28 swimmers) was won by New England Masters and Large Team (29 swimmers or more) was won by the host Pacific Northwest Association. In the Men's Club Scores the Small Team (11 swimmers or less) was won by El Segundo from California; Medium Team (12-23 swimmers) was won by The Olympic Club out of San Francisco; and the Large Team (34 swimmers or more) was won by Oregon Masters. And then there is combined club scoring with the Small Team (19 swimmers or less) being won by El Segundo; Medium Team (20-63 swimmers) won by the Olympic Club; and Large Team (64 swimmers or more) won by Pacific Northwest. There were many fine races providing lots of excitement and many USMS National records were broken at this fine facility!

THANKS TOM

We were indeed fortunate in having the services of Tom Logan as Editor of our magazine.

Unhappily, Tom announced his retirement. We profoundly regret his decision. He was the mainspring of FINA Masters News. We will not forget it and we thank him again.

Now, June F. Krauser, as editor, and the Secretariat at the FINA Office in Lausanne will be in charge of the coordination, preparation, printing and diffusion. With the cooperation of all Members of the FINA Masters Committee, the new team hopes to work as efficiently as Tom Logan did.

FINA MASTERS NEWS

The first issue of the FINA MASTERS NEWS, the Official Newsletter of the FINA Masters Committee was published in June of 1993. The Newsletter is published twice a year, in June and December and includes Masters Swimming World Records as of May 1st and November 1st. The first two issues contained eight pages but with the third issue the Newsletter now consists of twelve pages. There was a special issue in September of 1996 (No 8) with the results of the World Championships in Sheffield (GBR).

Tom Logan (NZL) was responsible for the nine issues published to date. Tom is to be thanked for his long devotion to the FINA Masters Committee. Tom resigned from the Committee in January and at the recent FINA Masters Committee meeting in May, June Krauser was appointed to replace him.
