Mary joined Brisbane Northside Masters in 1984 and became active at national level when she chaired the National Masters Games Committee from 1995-1997. Mary was President of QMS from 1992-1994 and was granted QMS Branch Life membership.

In 1996, she was appointed the Queensland Branch Delegate to the National Board and in 1999 was elected as National President. She completed three terms over six years.

Mary oversaw the appointment of a new National Executive Director and the relocation of the national office from Adelaide to Melbourne in 2001. During her time as National President, Mary was involved in many meetings with Swimming Australia and was a major player in the signing of a MOU with Swimming Australia in 2001. This was a landmark agreement put in place to ensure there was a co-ordinated approach with Swimming Australia in areas such as marketing, coaching and technical development.

Mary was also the national archivist from 2001 – 2005.

In 2005, She received an Exceptional Services award for 10 years of continuous service to AUSSI Masters Swimming.
