It is with pleasure that I welcome all swimmers to the First Australian Masters Games, to the City of Devonport and to the first National Masters Swim Meet to be held in Tasmania.

The Masters Games is an exciting concept that promises to give mature age sport its concepts and personal benefits as high public profile. These Games are a true "Festival of Sport", there being thirty five sporting competitions to be staged. The importance of sport to our Australian way of life is demonstrated by the number of people competing at more than one venue.

I wish to thank the volunteer officials in advance, all of whom are experienced ASI officials and I know their expertise will ensure a successful swim.

To all competitors, visitors and the many acquaintances I have made in a short swimming career — good luck, enjoy your swimming and your visit to Devonport.

#### **MEET RULES**

1. The swimming component of the First Australian Masters Games is being conducted by the Tasmanian Branch of AUSSI Masters Swimming in Australia Inc. Rules of swimming are AUSSI rules as at the 28th November 1987, will apply. Long distance swim rules are governed by the standard rules of FINA. The full detailed rules of Long Distance swimming are available at the Recorders/Registration desk.

#### 2. AGE

Age is in years as at the 29th November, 1987, Pool Swim. 30th November, 1987, Marathon Swim.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY

All adults 25 years of age and over may enter. Membership of AUSSI or any other organisation is not essential.

- 4. All events are timed heats. There will be no finals.
- **5.** All entries will be seeded from slowest to fastest.

#### 6. SCORING

A. Individual Events :— 1st 10 points
2nd 9 points
3rd 8 points and so on

B. Relays will score double :— 1st 20 points
2nd 18 points
3rd 16 points
4th 14 points

#### 7. AWARDS

Certificates will be presented to all swimmers showing; events swum, time, position, total points, place in age group.
GOLD MEDAL for 1st place in age group overall.

SILVER MEDAL for 2nd place in age group overall.

BRONZE MEDAL for 3rd place in age group overall.

#### **RELAY TROPHIES**

Points for relays are double individual events. A trophy will be awarded to the Club (i.e. AUSSI, Surf, Swimming etc.) gaining the most points in each relay age group from the six relay events, i.e. male, female and mixed freestyle and medley. Relay age groups will 100+, 120+, 160+, 200+, 240+, 280+.

8. Check programme to see that your entries are correct. Please read right through the event before claiming you have been left out. Should you wish to question your entries as printed or not printed, please report to the Registration Desk.

#### 9. MARSHALLING

Marshalling will be according to the heats and lanes as set out in the programme. It is your responsibility to report to the Marshall and be placed in your event prior to being handed over to the Check Starter under whose care you must remain until called to the blocks. Report promptly when your heat is called. Failure to report as requested will result in an automatic scratching.

After the heat preceding yours begins to swim, you must step forward and present your card to the Marshall and remain behind your block.

#### 10. FINISHING

Competitors must finish in the lane in which they started and must be sure to hit the electronic pad firmly. Then move back a metre or two from the end and hold on to the lane rope, BUT REMAIN IN YOUR LANE. On the signal from the referee (or after the next heat has started) competitors are to leave the water by the SIDE OF THE POOL ONLY. Take care leaving the pool, especially in relay events, and under no circumstances touch an electronic touch pad.

#### 11. STARTING

Except in backstroke events, swimmers may start on or beside the blocks or in the water provided that one hand is on the end of the pool when the start signal is given.

On the preparatory command from the Referee, the competitors will stand onto the surface and front of the starting block or pool edge, or in the water and remain there. On the preparatory command from the Starter "take your marks" the competitors shall immediately take up a starting position. When all competitors are stationary the Starter shall give the start signal.

#### 12. FALSE START

Should a false start occur the Starter shall recall the competitors by a second signal. A rope shall be held in readiness at a distance of fifteen metres from the starting point and shall be dropped if there is a false start. The starter shall at the first false start remind the competitors of not starting before the starting signal. After the second false start, the Starter shall call all competitors together and advise them that if the false start is repeated on a third occasion in an event, no matter if by the same or another swimmer(s) the Starter shall proceed with the start and with the concurrence of the Referee, disqualify the offender or offenders.

Where a competitor dives into the pool after being directed by the Starter to "stand up or stand down" following

a false start by another competitor, this shall be considered by the Starter and Referee as a disqualifiable infraction.

#### 13. DISQUALIFICATIONS

Swimmers must be aware that disqualifications may occur. Swimming strokes, starts, touches and turns must be in accordance with AUSSI rules.

No abuse of referees or officials will be tolerated.

#### 14. PROTESTS OR DISPUTES

Regarding the meet or results must come to the meet director. The necessary form must be completed and returned the same day as the dispute or protest occurred.

#### 15. WARM UP

The Learners Pool will be available for warm up at all times whilst venue is open.

We should remind you that there is to be NO diving in the Learners Pool as it is only 1 metre deep.

#### 16. SCRATCHINGS/WITHDRAWALS

Any swimmer who fails to report 15 minutes prior to his/her heat goes to the starting blocks will be scratched. Failure to report to the proper lane in the correct heat will also scratch a swimmer from that heat.

There is no penalty for scratching from an event, but it would be greatly appreciated if you notify the Registration Clerk that you intend to scratch from an event.

#### 17. RELAYS

- A. A swimmer may swim in only one (1) age group per event.
- B. Each day one (1) team member will be asked to :-
  - (i) Collect cards from officials
  - (ii) Enter all team members names and ages onto the cards
  - (iii) Age must add up to or over the total age of age group event
  - (iv) Return cards to officials.

#### 18. RESULTS

Will be posted as soon as possible after the conclusion of an event on the recorders office (backwall).



#### **SPECIAL NOTE TO SWIMMERS**

- 1. 50m Backstroke to start at deep end of pool.
- 2. RELAYS
  - .1 Members of entered relay teams must be registered Club members to gain championship points.
  - .2 Invitation relays will be swum at the end of each days programme.

Entries will be received from composite or club teams on completed relay cards until 1.00 p.m. each day.

Championship points will not be awarded for these events.

#### LONG DISTANCE SWIMMING



#### **RULES FOR THE CONDUCT**

#### OF LONG DISTANCE SWIMMING EVENTS

LONG DISTANCE SWIMMING: shall be defined as any event for which the distance is greater than 1500 metres.

#### THE REFEREE:

shall disqualify any competitor for any violation of the rules that he personally observes or which is reported to him by other authorized officials.

have the power to order a swimmer from the water upon expiry of any time limit so ordered by the Referee.

#### 1. THE START

- A. All long distance championships shall start with the swimmers standing or treading water in a depth sufficient for them to commence swimming on the start signal.
- B. The start line shall be clearly defined by either overhead appartus or by removable equipment at water level
- C. The referee shall indicate by a flag (held upright) and short blasts on a whistle when the start is imminent and indicate that the competition is under starters orders by pointing the flag at the Starter.
- D. The Starter shall be positioned so as to be clearly visible to all competitors.
- E. The start signal shall be both audible and visual.
- F. If in the opinion of the regeree unfair advantage has been gained at the start the competitions shall be stopped and restarted.
- G. All escort boats shall be stationed prior to the start so as not to interfere with any swimmer and if picking up their swimmer from behind shall navigate in such a way as not to manoeuver through the field of swimmers.

#### 2. THE VENUE

- A. The course shall be in water that is subject to only minor currents or tide and may be salt or fresh (sweet) water.
- B. The minimum depth of water at any point on the course shall be 1 metre.
- C. A clearly marked craft or platform, containing a turn judge, shall be positioned at all alterations of course in such a manner as not to obstruct a swimmers visibility of the turn.
- D. All turning apparatus and turn judges craft/platforms shall be securely fixed in position and not be subject to todal, wind or other movements.
- E. The finish shall be clearly defined and marked by a verticle face.

#### 3. THE RACE

- A. Obstructing, interfering with or making intentional contact with another swimmer shall, if in the opinion of the Referee be deemed "Unsporting Impedance" lead to disqualification whether made by a swimmer or their escort craft.
- B. Escort boats shall maintain a constant position at the side of their swimmer and shall manoeuver so as not to obstruct or place themselves directly ahead of another swimmer.
- C. Competitors shall not receive supportr from any fixed or floating object and shall not touch or be touched by their escort craft or crew therein.
- D. All competitors shall have their competition number clearly diusplayed in waterproof inks on their upper back or arms.
- E. No competitor shall be permitted to use or wear any device which may be an aid to their speed, endurance or buoyancy. Goggles, cap, noseclip and earplugs may be used.
- F. Competitors shall be allowed to use grease or other such substances providing these are not, in the opinion of the referee, excessive.
- G. A cut-off time limit of two hours, after the first competitor has finished, shall operate.



#### INSTRUCTIONS TO MARATHON SWIMMERS

- 1. Starting times: 10 km 10.00 a.m. 5 km 10.05 a.m.
- Course is approximately 715 metres.
   10 km event 14 laps
   km event 7 laps
- 3. Events to be conducted concurrently.
- 4. Competitors will be identified by numbers in programme.

  Numbers will be written on right shoulder and on back of supplied swim cap which must be worn.

  Officials take no responsibility for identifying a competitor not wearing their swim cap.
- 5. All competitors to be assembled by 9.30 a.m. for registration, collection of cap and numbering.
- 6. START: Competitors to enter water in order as commanded by starter and take position behind start/finish line.
- 7. Failure to pass on the outside or right hand side of course on all occasions will result in disqualification. A swimmer who passes inside a marker must return (go back) and pass on the outside of that marker.
- 8. Any swimmer moving off-course will be approached by an official. If the swimmer does not respond to a request by officials to resume course, he/she will be taken from the water.
- 9. Any swimmer feeling distressed should stop, raise their arm and call for help from support officials.
- 10. Wetsuits not permitted. Bathers, cap, goggles, earplugs, noseclip and preferred grease/vaseline may be used.
- 11. Because event is conducted around a circuit, swimmers will not have escort boats. Support craft will be positions around the inside of the course.
- 12. Age group winners will be the first across the finish line free of disqualification.
- 13. The Referee has the right not to start the event or to cancel the event at any time if he deems necessary.
- 14. Medals will be presented at the Presentation Function on the night of the event.
