Bob Barry was involved for many years in rugby union, lifesaving and masters swimming. Bob won his first swimming race at the age of four at Manly.

Bob narrowly missed a place on the swimming team for the Helsinki Olympic Games, however he continued to swim and joined Wollongong masters in 1986.

During his master's career, Bob collected many NSW Branch Records as well as 80 LC national and 67 SC national records and 19 World Records.

Competed at several World Championships including Indianapolis, Sheffield, Christchurch, Tokyo, Brisbane; World Masters Games: Brisbane, Melbourne,

Bob achieved World Top Ten rankings in the years 1988, 1992-2007.
