



2025 MSA TECHNICAL OFFICIAL OF THE YEAR NOMINATION FORM

The **Masters Swimming Australia (MSA) Technical Official of the Year Award** provides the opportunity to recognise the valuable contribution that Technical Officials make to Masters Swimming in Australia. If a State has a Technical Official who meets the criteria, we encourage you to consider nominating them for this prestigious award.

Eligibility

States/Territories may only nominate one (1) Technical Official for the 2025 Technical Official of the Year Award. **This Official may have worked in any position defined in the MSA Swimming Rules, under rule SW 2 – Officials, other than Timekeeper (SW 2.9).** Only achievements for the period of 1 January to 31 December 2025 will be considered as part of the application.

To be eligible for consideration:

- Nominees must have officiated at 50% of the MSA sanctioned meets in their State / Territory during the year;
- Nominees must have at all times adhered to the “Officials Code of Ethics” and practised and espoused a philosophy of diplomacy, impartiality and fair play;
- Nominees must present a positive image of officiating and the role of the official;
- Nominees must have made an outstanding contribution in officiating and/or towards the development of officiating at Club, State/Territory and/or National level.
- All sections of the nomination form must be completed;
- Nominations must be endorsed by their respective State/Territory;
- Nominations must be received by the National Office no later than **28 February 2026 extended to Monday 9 March 2026** to be eligible for consideration.

Submissions need to be well documented and relate to the criteria. The Technical Official of the Year for 2025 should be an individual who has achieved excellence as a **Technical** Official. *Implementation of innovative ideas to improve officiating and extra activities related to officiating, such as leadership, accreditation and professionalism* will also be considered. In the application, indicate the significance of the achievement and the value to the organisation and the masters’ swimming community, including their contribution to the development of Technical Officials.

Selection Process

The National Technical Committee will review the nominations and recommend the winner, who is subject to ratification by the MSA National Board. Any person who is a nominee cannot participate in the selection process. The winner will be announced at the National Championships Presentation function and (if logistics allow) be presented there with a trophy to be retained outright.


