

There are many people who make wonderful contributions to Masters Swimming in Australia at Club, State, National and/or International levels. In 2016, the State/Territory Delegates agreed to establish a new and prestigious award to recognise and reward a person who has been an outstanding volunteer at the National level.

States/Territories are invited to nominate an individual for their valuable contribution to our sport at a National level during the past year. This could have been as a National Championship organising committee member, National Committee Chairperson or member, National Board member, National Director, National Delegate, a significant contributor at National level in another way etc.

The award recipient will be reviewed and selected by the MSA National Board and (if logistics allow) be presented with their individual trophy at the annual National Championships Presentation Function.

Eligibility

To be eligible for consideration:

- All sections of the nomination form must be completed;
- Nominees must meet all of the minimum criteria;
- Nominations must be endorsed and submitted by a State/Territory or the MSA National Board;
- Nominations must be received by the National Office no later than **Monday 9 March 2026** to be eligible for consideration;
- Nominees may be a non-member of MSA;
- The nominee **is NOT** nominated for either the MSA Coaching Excellence Award or the MSA Official of the Year Award for the same year.

Submissions need to be well documented and relate to the criteria. Each State/Territory may only nominate one volunteer for the **2025 Volunteer of the Year Award**. Note that only achievements for the period of **1 January 2025 to 31 December 2025** will be considered.

Selection Process

The MSA National Board will review the nominations and select a winner. Any person who is a nominee cannot participate in the selection process.

The winner will be announced at the National Championships Presentation function and (if logistics allow) be presented there with a trophy to be retained outright.
